Exhibitor Information

CLASS ENTRIES close and may not be accepted more than 30 minutes after the show ends each day. Class entries received after numbers are picked up may be charged an additional \$5 post entry fee per class. Exception: Lead Line Class may be added on the same day and post entry fees do not apply. Exhibitors are advised to enter all classes they may do prior to picking up numbers to avoid post entry fees and the risk of being closed out. Classes may be scratched for full credit prior to the start of the class on proper paperwork in the show office, excluding any Medal Class or Hunter/Equitation Classic. *Numbers will not be released nor may any person ride a horse unless both OCHSA & Blenheim Equisports liability release is signed.*

CLASS SIGN-IN SHEETS may be posted with a specific starting time for each class with an allotted amount of time. Classes may end at the scheduled finish time. Posted orders may be imposed at any time.

ARENA LIGHTING is not available at the RMV Riding Park. It is imperative that all classes be conducted during daylight hours. Start times and schedules may be adjusted to accommodate the number of entries. It is the rider's responsibility to check with the Horse Show Office or back gate regarding changes in the show schedule.

VEHICLE PARKING, GOLF CART, BICYCLE USAGE & DOG REGULATIONS will be strictly enforced for your safety and protection. Parking of vehicles is not permitted within barn areas. NO BICYCLES ARE ALLOWED NEAR THE IN GATES. Recreational use of bicycles is not allowed. All dogs must be on a leash and are not permitted in horse show areas. Please park golf carts away from entrance to all arenas. Carts operated after daylight hours must have functioning headlights. GOLF CARTS MAY ONLY BE DRIVEN BY PERSONS WITH A VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE. Please complete entry form online. It is necessary for each entry form to be accompanied with a check made payable to OCHSA or credit card information for each stall and nominating fee. (See schedule of fees below for stall and nominating charges). An additional open check or credit card number will be necessary for an exhibitor to obtain their 'rider back number'. Inquiries must be settled with the OCHSA office prior to the close of entries. Inquiries can be called into Lance Bennett at 760-525-8933 *Numbers will not be released nor may any person ride a horse unless both OCHSA & Blenheim Equisports liability release is signed.*

The General Release of Claims must be signed by all Exhibitors, Parents or Guardians.

Classes may be scratched for a full credit with the proper paperwork submitted to the Horse Show Office prior to the start of the class.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Stalls are available for \$275. Stall assignments will be made and your request will need to be accompanied by a payment in full for the stall and nomination fee. Nomination fees are \$60 per horse. Open checks received will be completed and negotiated for the stall fee and nomination amount of \$335 (non-refundable).

Shavings may be ordered by calling Lance 760-525-8933 prior to the show or through the Horse Show office the office is informed by Friday, November 4th, 2022 by 5:00 pm. once the show has started. Shavings, once ordered, are nonrefundable.

No refunds on stalls, tack rooms or shavings once ordered. Nomination fees are non refundable.

Entries must be postmarked by October 24, 2022 and accompanied by a stall and nomination fee payment. Entries postmarked after October 24, 2022 will be considered late. An additional \$50 may be added for entries not received by the deadline. All class post entries (classes added after numbers are picked up) other than Lead Line, Costume Class, and Ride and Drive must be made one day prior to showing or 30 minutes after the show ends.

Orders of go will be drawn for every Medal and Special Class. The order of go will be posted at the show office and on www. horseshowtime.com by 9:00 pm the day prior to the class and at the ring by 7:00 am on the show day. A two-minute gate rule may be enforced and starters will have the authority to scratch horses not ready to go in the posted order. Horses may move up in the order, but not down. All conflicts must be brought to the attention of the Paddock Masters.

Helmets must be worn at all times while riding - there are NO EXCEPTIONS.

Management: The Horse Show Management reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All Questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management and their decision is final. The Horse Show Management reserves to itself the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify riders or exhibitors, prohibit claim damages; to change any course, to cancel or combine any unfilled Scratched classes will be refunded as long as the proper paper work classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges, and to change specifications in

> It is the responsibility of owners, exhibitors and their agents to respect the RMVRP Facility. Visitors will be charged for any dam-age to their stalls, buildings and other properties on the show grounds. Employees have the authority to monitor and oversee the area. Exhibitors, horses, dogs, golf carts and bikes are not allowed on any grass field.

Assumption of Risk: By signing the entry blank, the Owner, Parent, Guardian, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur acknowledges that horseback riding, particularly jumping, is a dangerous activity and involves inherent risks that may cause serious injury and in some cases death because of the unpredictable nature and irrational behavior of horses, regardless of their training and past performance and expressly assumes all such inherent risks whether identified here-in, in the entry blank or in the Federation Rules and Regulations. A horse without warning or any apparent cause can buck, stumble, fall, rear, bite, kick, run, make unpredictable movements, spook, jump obstacles, step on a person's foot or push a person-all of which may cause the rider or observer to fall or be jolted, resulting in serious injury or death. A horse may also become loose and cause injury to an observer or rider or to another horse-a loose horse can run at a full gallop in a panic and run into objects or persons or other horses. The Show Ground Facilities are bordered by highways/roads and thus noise from traffic and other sources occurs that can and will cause a horse to unexpectedly spook or react quickly. The Show Ground Facilities contain roads and driveways that are traversed by cars, golf carts, tractors, trailers and heavy equipment all of which may spook a horse. The above warnings and risks are meant as an example of some of the risks that are inherent and may be encountered, but it is agreed this is not an exhaustive list and there are numerous additional conditions and/or events that may result in injuries while participating in the Competition and/or present on the Show Ground Facilities.

Minor exhibitors; Parents or Guardians of minor exhibitors shall hold RMVRP and the Orange County Horse Show Association, Inc. harmless for injury to such minor. No child's entry will be accepted unless a parent or guardian signs the entry blank.

Exhibitors are responsible for entering only in classes for which they are eligible and for observing all cross entry restric-tions. The show office is not responsible for checking class entries. In the event that an exhibitor enters and receives an award in a class for which they were ineligible, the award must be returned for redistribution. Applicable class fees will still apply.


Judges' decisions are final and are not subject to protest.

Once a class has commenced, it will be run and prizes will be awarded based upon the decision of the judges. In the event of a protest, awards may be subject to later redistribution.

Protests of horse/rider eligibility or concerning the application of rules at this horse show must be made in writing (form available in the Horse Show Office.) The completed Protest Form, along with a \$100 protest fee made payable to OCHSA should be submitted to the Show Technical Delegate, Robin Serfass. Where OCHSA rules do not apply, rules of USEF may be used.

Verbal protests cannot be considered. Protests must be made prior to the conclusion of the show. The Protest Committee shall consist of the Technical Delegate, the Show Manager and an OCHSA representative. The Protest Committee shall issue a ruling on the protest. If the protest is upheld, the protest fee will be refunded.

The Horse Show Office will be open from 7:00 am on show days and close 30 minutes after the last class finishes. Entries for the following day must be made by 5:00 pm, the day before.

The Hunter Championships

The Open Hunter Championships are open to all horses. Horses will compete over a minimum of seven (7) fences with two (2) changes of direction. The area of a courtesy circle may be restricted by a mandatory dotted line and will be indicated on the course diagram and designated by a physical barrier placed in the arena. Course diagrams will be posted at least one hour prior to each Hunter class. Hunters will be judged on performance and soundness. Riders and owners must be a current OCHSA member. **Cross entry restrictions for over fence classes to also apply to Under Saddle classes. No cross entry restrictions in warm-up classes.**







In a two round format, a minimum of two judges will utilize the open numerical system to score competitors in the Classic Hunter round (first round) on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and substance, and movement. To be shown over hunter derby style fences set at 3' and 3'3". Jump appearances may include hay bales, option fences, natural foliage, natural standards and rails. Courses will be somewhat challenging but appropriate. Top 10 horse and rider combinations with the highest scores will return for the Handy Hunter Round (second round) which reflects brilliance of page and handiness. Trot or hand gallop fence permitted in Handy Hunter Round. Hand turns will be built into the second round course. The top 10 horse and rider combinations are asked to stay present for a special awards and victory gallop.

510/511. Interactive Mortgage Tommy Gallagher .80m- 1.0m Gambler's Choice

Class 510 is the .80m and class 511 is the 1.0m division. Riders may not enter jumper classes under .90m at the Championship show. The horse & rider combinations may enter only one Gambler's Choice Class. Class 510 and 511 are open to Junior, Amateur and Professional riders. A course of multiple jumps are set. Each obstacle carries from 10 to 120 points according to its difficulty. Combination obstacles are not allowed. The obstacles must be built so that they can be jumped both directions. The rider is credited with the number of points carried by each obstacle that they have jumped correctly. No points are awarded for an obstacle knocked down. Each rider has 45 seconds (minimum) to 90 seconds (maximum). During this time, they may jump all obstacles of choice in any order and in any direction. The rider may cross the starting line and finishing line in either direction. Each obstacle may be jumped twice. The buzzer declares the end of the round. The rider must then cross the finish line in one direction or the other to allow their time to be recorded. If the rider does not cross the finish line, they are placed behind the last of the competitors with the same number of points. If the fixed time is reached at the moment when the horse is already taking off, this obstacle counts if it is correctly jumped. Any obstacle knocked down during a round will not be rebuilt and should not be jumped again. The rider who has obtained the highest number of points will be declared the winner. In the event of equality of points, the fastest time taken between the starting line and the finish line will decide. An obstacle will be provided and marked "Joker". 200 points are awarded for this obstacle, but if knocked down, 200 points must be deducted from the total points obtained.

The rider is required to jump the joker jump within 20 seconds after the fixed time has expired and after the rider has crossed the finish line -- only one attempt.

400. Dana Smith Show Team .85m Jumper Equitation Medal

Sponsored by: Dana Smith Show Team Open to Junior and Amateur riders. Riders must be a current OCHSA member. Competitors must use the same horse in both phases. Horse and Rider may not jump more than .85 at the Championship Show. The jumping phase of the class shall be over a course of at least eight (3) fences, .85 in height with spreads to .70. To be judged on style and execution. All riders will be invited to return for the final phase. In the flat phase, not more then 20 riders at one time will show as a group at the walk, the trot rising, and the canter. Judges may require any additional tests. To be judged on the rider's position, seat, and the correctness and effectiveness of the aids. Judging consists of 60% over fences and 40% on the flat.

404F. Dana Smith Jumper Equitation Medal Final Flat Phase

Sponsored by: Dana Smith Show Team Open to Junior and Amateur riders. Riders must be a current OCHSA member and have participated in class 400. Competitors must use the same horse in both phases. In the flat phase, not more then 20 riders at one time will show as a group at the walk, the trot rising, and the canter. To be judged on the riders position, seat, and correctness and effectiveness of the aids. Judging consists of 60% over fences and 40% on the flat.

402. Caroline Bonham Memorial Medal 2'9"
